NOTIFICATION

It is notified that the following amendments to Ordinance 20 of Chapter V ‘Degree Certificates and Mark lists’ of the Kannur University Ordinances, 1999 passed by the Syndicate at its meeting held on 17/01/2017 and Ordinance 3(1) of Chapter XV-‘The scale pay, age etc. for non-teaching posts’ passed by the Syndicate at its meeting held on 03/05/2019 have been assented to by the Chancellor on 01/11/2019.

The amendments to Ordinances shall be deemed to have come in to force with effect from 01/11/2019.

Amendment No. 1

Amendment to Ordinance 20 of Chapter V –‘ Degree Certificates and Mark lists’ of the Kannur University Ordinances, 1999.

That the existing provision in Ordinance 20 ‘Degree Certificates and Mark lists’ in the Chapter V of the Kannur University Ordinances, 1999 is amended as follows.
