NOTIFICATION

It is notified that the following amendments to Statute 43 of Chapter XLVII Part C of the **Kannur University First Statutes 1998** passed by the Syndicate at its meeting held on 12/03/2018 and Statute 31(2), 31(3) & Statute 3 of Chapter V passed by the Syndicate at its meeting held on 31/01/2019 have been assented to by the Chancellor on 01/10/2019.

The amendments to Statute shall be deemed to have come into force with effect from 01/10/2019.

Amendment No. 1

Amendment to Statute 43 of CHAPTER XLVII Part C – ‘Qualification for appointment’ of the Kannur University First Statutes, 1998.

That, in Statute 43 under Chapter XLVII Part C of **Kannur University First Statutes 1998- ‘Qualification for appointment’**, after Sl. No.4, the following be added as 4(a).

Existing Statute	Statutes after Amendment
CHAPTER XLVII- Part C-Conditions of Service of Members of Non - Teaching Staff- Statute 43- ‘Qualification for appointment’. A new clause to be added as Sl. No.4(a) under Sl. No. 4	4(a). UD Typist in Private Aided Colleges who possesses prescribed qualifications may be promoted as UD Clerks in Private Aided colleges based on common seniority, without any financial commitment.


Amendment No. 2

Amendment to Statute 31(2), Statute 31(3), Statute 3 of CHAPTER V – ‘Affiliation of Colleges’ of the Kannur University First Statutes, 1998.

That the existing clause 2 & 3 of Statute 31 and Statute 3 in Chapter V- **Affiliation of Colleges’ of the Kannur University First Statutes, 1998** be replaced as follows.
