ORDER

As per the papers read first, second, third and fourth above, Arts and Sports Grace Marks to the students who participate in Arts/Sports/Games activities was implemented in the University and Grace Marks was awarded to the students.

The combined meeting of the special standing committee on Exam and Discipline and Director of students welfare at its meeting held on 3-03-2004 authorized the Director of Students Service to submit a detailed proposal for awarding Grace Marks.

Accordingly, the Director of Student Services submitted a detailed proposal for awarding Grace Marks to the students who are deaf and dumb and also those who excel in Arts, Sports, NSS and NCC. The syndicate Meeting held on 24-06-2004 vide item No.2004-175 resolved to approve the proposals for revising grace marks to the students who excel in Art festival, Sports events, NCC, NSS and also to the deaf and dumb students. The meeting also resolved that this revised proposal may be given effect from 2004 March/April Examinations.

As per the U.O read fifth above, revised grace marks order was issued from the Director of Student Services' Office and the same has to be kept pending due to practical difficulties in implementing the same from March/April 2004 Examinations.

After considering the matter, Vice-Chancellor has accorded sanction to approve the syndicate decision and the revised Grace Marks shall be implemented with effect from March/April 2004 examination onwards.

Explanatory Note:

1. Candidates with Inter Collegiate/State I 6%
2. Candidates with Inter Collegiate/State I & University rep/selection 8%+2%=10%
3. Candidates with Inter Collegiate/State and Inter University I 18%+2%=20%

Grace Marks shall be awarded strictly observing the following guidelines

1. Grace marks shall be awarded for any one of the highest achievements in the Arts Festival Competitions and Sports events.
2. The basic qualification for the award of grace marks is participation in the Inter Collegiate Arts/Sports competitions of Kannur University and if selected, representing the University, in the discipline for which grace marks are claimed.
3. Grace Marks shall be awarded to the candidates based on the maximum aggregate marks of the examinations conducted by the University of the year of participation/representation.
4. Grace marks shall be given for all the papers/parts/subjects of the course in a year, irrespective of whether the course is annual or semester. For semester course the percentage shall be the same applicable to the annual scheme.
5. In the case of both the semester and annual courses, the academic year shall be taken as from 1st June to 31st May.
6. The Association of Indian Universities approved N+1, N+2 are also eligible for the grace marks just as regular students.
7. Grace marks shall be awarded to the candidate on the basis of his/her performance in the respective academic year.
8. Grace marks shall be awarded for Undergraduate and Postgraduate courses except for professional courses like Engineering, Medical, Para-medical, BEd and MEd courses. For P.G courses, the total marks after awarding Grace marks shall not exceed 55% of the maximum marks of the year of participation.
9. Grace marks shall not be considered for ranking.
10. Deaf and Dumb candidates with disability of 40% or above, on production of a medical certificate obtained from a medical Board are only eligible for Grace Marks.
11. Applications with all relevant documents and attested copies of certificates and hall tickets shall be submitted to the University through the head of the Institution within the stipulated time announced by the University. An amount of Rs.100/- shall be collected as fine for late applications. Proper entry shall be made in the originals of certificates of proficiency by the office of the verifying authority.
12. Maximum grace marks awarded to a student in a particular year for all the activities [Sports/Arts/N.C.C/N.S.S.] put together shall not exceed 20%, except in the case of representing the country for International competitions where the maximum is 25%

13. Grace marks shall be distributed to the advantage of the candidate at the time of finalization of the result before awarding moderation marks, if any.
14. The Director of Physical Education shall collect the list of Spots/Games events approved by the Kerala Sports Council and recommendation shall be regulated accordingly.
15. The Students shall claim the grace marks while finalizing the results of the academic year concerned.
16. The Vice-Chancellor, after considering the matter in detail, has ordered to implement the decision of the Syndicate in respect of awarding Grace Marks with effect from March 2004 exam.
17. Orders are issued accordingly and all the earlier University Orders issued in this regard stands modified to this extend.
