Amendment No. 1

Amendment to Statute 43 of CHAPTER XLVII Part C – 'Qualification for appointment' of the Kannur University First Statutes, 1998.

That, in Statute 43 under Chapter XLVII Part C of Kannur University First Statutes 1998- 'Qualification for appointment', after Sl. No.4, the following be added as 4(a).

That the existing clause 2 & 3 of Statute 31 and Statute 3 in Chapter V- Affiliation of Colleges' of the Kannur University First Statutes, 1998 be replaced as follows.
