ORDER

1. As per the paper read as (1) above, the Kunhitharuvayi Memorial Charitable Trust, Kasaragod, submitted an application for starting a new unaided Law College at Kasaragod under the name KMCT College of Legal Studies, Kasaragod.
2. The documents and other records submitted by the Educational Agency were duly verified by the University. Based on the request submitted by the Trust for obtaining sanction from the Higher Education Department and approval from the Bar Council of India (BCI), and subject to the applicable provisions, Kannur University granted the Consent of Affiliation certificate for starting the proposed Law College, as per the paper read as (2) above.
3. Subsequently, the Higher Education Department, Government of Kerala, granted administrative sanction for the proposed Law College, and the Government also issued the required No Objection Certificate (NOC), as per the papers read as (3) and (4) above.
4. As per the paper read as (5) above, the Bar Council of India (BCI) granted approval for starting the B.A. LL.B. (5-Year Integrated) and LL.B. (3-Year) programmes at the proposed College, with an intake of 120 students in each programme.
5. After obtaining the Government administrative sanction, NOC and approval of the Bar Council of India, Kannur University conducted a second inspection of the proposed College. The Inspection Commission, after examining the facilities and other requirements, recommended the commencement of the B.A. LL.B. (5-Year Integrated) and LL.B. (3-Year) programmes with an intake of 120 students each, as per the paper read as (6) above. The Inspection Commission's report was considered and approved by the Vice-Chancellor, as per the paper read as (7) above.
6. The University subsequently directed the Educational Agency to remit the prescribed affiliation, administration and registration fees and to furnish the Financial Guarantee, as required under Chapter V, Statute 23 of the Kannur University Statutes, 1998, as per the letter read as (8) above.
7. The Kunhitharuvayi Memorial Charitable Trust remitted the prescribed fees and submitted the required Financial Guarantee and requested the University to grant Provisional Affiliation for the commencement of the programmes, as per the paper read as (9) above.
8. After considering the matter in detail, the Vice-Chancellor has accorded sanction for granting Provisional Affiliation to the new Law College, namely KMCT College of Legal Studies, Kasaragod, under the management of Kunhitharuvayi Memorial Charitable Trust, Kasaragod, for the academic year 2026–27, subject to the conditions stipulated below:

10. The Provisional Affiliation granted herein shall be subject to the provisions of the Kannur University Act, Statutes, Ordinances, Rules and Regulations, and the orders, rules and regulations of the Government of Kerala, as amended from time to time, in all matters relating to the College.
11. The College shall follow the Scheme and Syllabus approved by the University for the respective programmes and shall comply with all academic requirements prescribed by the University from time to time.
12. The Provisional Affiliation granted herein shall be valid only for the academic year 2026–27.
13. Admission to the programmes in any subsequent academic year shall be made only after obtaining Continuation of Provisional Affiliation from Kannur University, subject to the fulfilment of all conditions prescribed by the University and other competent authorities.
