6. Orders are issued accordingly.



1. Regulations for the three year Under Graduate programmes in tune with FYUGP pattern under Private Registration Scheme was approved and implemented in School of Lifelong Learning (SLL) of Kannur University w.e.f. 2024 admission vide paper read (1) above.
2. Subsequently, the List of Courses and Pathways for the three year Under Graduate programmes, prepared as per the FYUGP pattern, under the Private Registration scheme of School of Life Long Learning was approved and implemented vide paper read (2) above.
3. Meanwhile, the School of Life Long Learning vide paper read 3 above, forwarded the Representation of the Students enrolled for B.A. Arabic and Islamic History programme (double major) in FYUGP pattern under Private registration scheme, during the academic year 2024-25, to include two more Courses (**KU3MDCISH102- Gulf Migration in Kerala: Dynamics, Impacts and Challenges, KU1DSCISH101-Islamic History as a Social Science Discipline**) in addition to the already fixed Courses for Islamic History.
- 4.The Chairperson BoS, Islamic History vide paper read 4 recommended to include the aforementioned two courses, (included in the Syllabus of Regular Programme), in the List of courses for Islamic History of BA Urdu & Islamic History and BA Arabic & Islamic History Programme under Private Registration scheme of SLL.
4. Considering the matter, the Vice Chancellor ordered to place the matter before the Standing Committee of Academic Council for consideration.
5. The Standing Committee of the Academic Council, vide paper read 5, recommended to approve the same.
6. Therefore, Vice Chancellor, after considering the Recommendation of the Standing Committee Academic Council and exercising the powers of the Academic Council conferred

under Section 11(1) Chapter III of the Kannur University Act,1996, accorded sanction to include two Courses viz, 1. **KU3MDCISH102- 'Gulf Migration in Kerala: Dynamics, Impacts and Challenges'** and 2. **KU1DSCISH101-'Islamic History as a Social Science Discipline' in the List of courses for Islamic History of B.A. Urdu & Islamic History and B.A. Arabic & Islamic History (Double Major) Programme (FYUGP) under Private Registration Scheme of the School of Lifelong Learning (SLL) of the University w.e.f. 2024 admission, subject to reporting to the Academic Council.**



Instructions for selecting Minors

1. Minor courses are offered in First, Second and third Semesters .(6 courses , 24 credits (6 x 4 =24). 2 course in First, 2 course in second and 2 course in third semester.

2. **In first semester**, a candidate shall choose **any TWO courses** from the above courses as Minors, from any discipline of their choice other than their Major.

Eg:- A candidate registered for B.A History (ie, History as Major) can select any two courses as Minors from any discipline other than from History.

3. A candidate who earns 24 credits in 6 minor courses in a particular discipline (other than her/his Major discipline) is eligible for a Minor Degree in that discipline if she/he is eligible for a Degree with a Major.

Eg:- Major History with Economics minor

4. A candidate who secures 12 credits choosing three minor courses in a particular disciplines (other than her/his major discipline) is eligible to get mentioned her/his competencies in that discipline along with major degree. In this way, a maximum of two disciplines with 12 credits from 3 courses in each discipline can be mentioned with Major degree.

Eg:- Major History with Economics & English (12 credits in Economics and 12 credits in English)

5. Candidates who chooses 6 minor courses from different disciplines and earns 24 credits will be eligible for a major degree only if they are otherwise eligible for a major degree.

Instructions for selecting Minors

1. Minor courses are offered in First, Second and third Semesters. (6 courses , 24 credits (6 x 4 =24). 2 course in First, 2 course in second and 2 course in third semester.
2. **In second semester**, a candidate shall choose **any TWO courses** from the above courses as Minors, from any discipline of their choice other than their Major.

Eg:- A candidate registered for B.A History (ie, History as Major) can select any two courses as Minors from any discipline other than from History.

3. A candidate who earns 24 credits in 6 minor courses in a particular discipline (other than her/his Major discipline) is eligible for a Minor Degree in that discipline if she/he is eligible for a Degree with a Major.

Eg:- Major History with Economics minor

4. A candidate who secures 12 credits choosing three minor courses in a particular disciplines (other than her/his major discipline) is eligible to get mentioned her/his competencies in that discipline along with major degree. In this way, a maximum of two disciplines with 12 credits from 3 courses in each discipline can be mentioned with Major degree.

Eg:- Major History with Economics & English (12 credits in Economics and 12 credits in English)

5. Candidates who chooses 6 minor courses from different disciplines and earns 24 credits will be eligible for a major degree only if they are otherwise eligible for a major degree.
