ORDER

1. The Regulations for Post Graduate Programmes under Choice Based Credit Semester System in the Schools/Departments of Kannur University were implemented w.e.f 2020 admission as per paper read (1) above.
2. Clause 6.2 states that "***Open Elective Courses can be opted in any of the semesters during the entire Programme other than the first semester. The maximum students that can be admitted to an Open Elective Course is limited to forty(40) except for MOOC Courses. If the student intake in the Department is more than 40, then the maximum number of students that can be admitted to an Open Elective Course is equal to the student intake.***
3. Meeting of Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) held on 27/07/2022 above, resolved to make Open Elective Courses from other Departments compulsory for all Post Graduate students of the Schools/Departments of Kannur University, in the Third semester as per paper read(2) above.
4. Clause 6.8 states that "**The total credits required for the successful completion of a four semester Programme will be between 72 to 80. The maximum credits assigned to Core Courses for non- science subjects should not exceed 50 percent of total required credits. For science subjects the maximum credits for core courses should not exceed 70 percent of the total required credits**".
5. As per paper read (3) above, Online Meeting of the HoDs of the Teaching Departments of the University recommended to modify the Clause 6.8 of the existing Regulations by changing the total credits "between 72-80" as "between 72-84".
6. As per paper read (4) above, modified Guidelines for the conduct of Open Elective Courses were implemented in the Teaching Departments of Kannur University w.e.f 2021 admission.
7. In compliance with the decisions of the meeting of Internal Quality Assurance Cell, Online meeting of the HoDs of the Teaching Departments and also the modified guidelines for the conduct of Open Elective Courses, Clause 6.2 and Clause 6.8 of the Regulations for Post Graduate Programmes under CBCSS in the Schools/Departments of Kannur University (implemented w.e.f 2020 admission) was modified in consultation with Karthikeyan P, CBCSS & Time Table Coordinator as well as the Convenor of the Committee constituted for monitoring the conduct of Open Elective Courses in the Teaching Departments, as follows:

6.2: Open Elective Courses can be opted in any of the semesters during the entire

Programme other than the first semester. In the third semester all students shall compulsorily register for an Open Elective Course offered by other Departments or MOOC.

6.8: The total credits required for the successful completion of a four semester Programme will be between 72 to 84. The maximum credits assigned to Core Courses for non- science subjects should not exceed 50 percent of total required credits. For science subjects the maximum credits for core courses should not exceed 70 percent of the total required credits

8. The Vice Chancellor after considering the matter in detail and in exercise of the powers of the Academic Council conferred under section 11(1), Chapter III of Kannur University Act 1996, accorded sanction to revise the Regulations for Post Graduate Programmes under Choice Based Credit Semester System in the Schools/Departments of Kannur University, w.e.f 2021 admission onwards, by modifying clauses 6.2 and 6.8 as detailed in paragraph 7 above, and to report the same to Academic Council.

9. Revised Regulations for Post Graduate Programmes under Choice Based Credit Semester System in the Schools/Departments of Kannur University w.e.f 2021, is appended and uploaded in the University Website (www.kannuruniversity.ac.in)

10. UO read vide paper (1) above stands modified to this extent.
