ORDER

1. Regulation, Scheme and Syllabus of two year M.Ed Programme (CBCSS) in tune with NCTE Regulation 2014 was implemented in the University Departments with effect from 2020 admission as per paper read (1) above and "Clause 19 pass requirement" was modified as per paper read (2) above.

2. As per modification effected to Clause 19 - Pass Requirement-

"The minimum marks required for a pass in MEd Degree Examination shall be 50% in the aggregate for Theory, Dissertation and Viva Voce.

The minimum requirement for a pass in each theory paper shall be 50%, in which external examination (theory) shall be 45 % and 50% for internal assessment.

Those who failed to secure the minimum percentage of marks as mentioned above, need to re appear for the examination in the particular paper and shall secure 50% marks".

3. Examination branch, as per paper read (3) above, sought clarification whether the minimum marks required for a pass in MEd Degree Examination shall be applicable for each course and also for each semester of the programme.

4. As per paper read(4) above, HoD, School of Pedagogical Sciences was requested to offer necessary clarifications in this regard.

5. As per paper read(5) above, HoD, School of Pedagogical Sciences submitted the following clarification.

*"The minimum marks required for a pass in the MEd Degree Examination shall be 50% in aggregate for Theory, Dissertation and Viva Voce. The minimum marks requirement for a pass in each theory paper shall be 50% in which external examination (Theory) shall be 45% and 50% for internal assessment. **This is applicable for each Core Courses, Elective Courses, Specialization Courses, Dissertation, Viva Voce, Practical/Internship and also for each semester of the MEd programme.** A student who fails to to secure the minimum percentage of marks required for a pass in a theory paper need to reappear for the examination in the particular paper concerned only and shall secure 50% marks. Students who register his/her name for the University Examination (External Exam) for a semester will be eligible for promotion to the next semester."*

6. The Vice Chancellor, after considering the matter in detail and in exercise of the powers of the Academic Council conferred under section 11 (1) Chapter III of Kannur University Act 1996, accorded sanction to modify "Clause 19 - Pass requirement" as detailed in Para (5) above,

for M.Ed. programme [CBCSS] in the School of Pedagogical Sciences, Kannur University with effect from 2020 admission, subject to reporting to the Academic Council.

7. The modified Regulation/Syllabus of M.Ed. programme under CBCSS implemented with effect from 2020 admission are uploaded on the University Website (www.kannuruniversity.ac.in).

9. The U. O read (1) & (2) above stands modified to this effect.
