After considering the report submitted by the Convener of the committee, the Vice Chancellor, in exercise of the powers of the Academic Council conferred under Section 11(1) Chapter III of Kannur University Act, 1996 and all other enabling provisions read together with **approved the Syllabus of the Certificate course - English for Practical Purposes (EPP) and accorded sanction to implement the same under Centre for Life Long Learning under School of Life Long Learning of the University w.e.f.2023-24 academic year, subject to report to the Academic Council.**
- 6.The School of Life Long Learning vide paper read 6 above, forwarded the approved syllabus to the Academic Branch and requested to issue formal University Order in this regard.


