Now these presents witness and it is hereby mutually agreed as follows:

1. In case the tender submitted by the bounden is accepted by the University and the contract for ..... is awarded to the bounden, the bounden shall within..... days of acceptance of his tender execute an agreement with the University incorporating all the terms and conditions under which the University accepts his tender.

In case the bounden fails to execute the agreement as aforesaid incorporating the terms and conditions governing the contract the University shall have power and authority to recover from the bounden any loss or damage caused to the University by such breach as may be determined by the University by appropriating the earnest money deposited by the bounden and if the earnest money is found to be inadequate the deficit amount may be recovered from the bounden and his properties, movable and immovable, in the manner hereinafter contained.

All sums found due to the University under or by virtue of this agreement shall be recoverable from the bounden and his properties movable and immovable under the provisions of the Revenue Recovery Act for the time being in force as though such sums are arrears of land revenue and in such other manner as the University may deem fit.
