ORDER

1. The revised Regulations for UG Programmes under the Choice Based Credit Semester System in Affiliated Colleges were implemented in the University w.e.f 2014 admission as per the paper read (1) above. Certain modifications were effected to the same vide papers read (2) & (3).
2. A One-time mercy chance examination was permitted to the Under Graduate (2014 Regulation) candidates vide paper read (4) above, by relaxing Clause 6.2 of the Regulations for UG Programmes under the Choice Based Credit Semester System implemented in Affiliated Colleges w.e.f 2014 admission .
3. As per the papers read (6) & (7) Mercy Chance Examinations were permitted to the Post Graduate (2014 regulation) candidates, by relaxing Clause 4.1 of the Regulations for PG Programmes under the Credit Based Semester System implemented in Affiliated Colleges w.e.f 2014 admission, vide paper read (5) .
4. The Examination Branch as per the paper read (8) above, requested to take necessary steps to conduct Mercy Chance Examinations for eligible candidates who enrolled for UG Programmes under Choice Based Credit Semester System (2014 Syllabus) and PG Programmes under Credit Based Semester System in affiliated Colleges (2014 Syllabus) .
5. Subsequently the matter was placed before the Standing Committee of the Academic Council held on 05.12.2025 and the Vice Chancellor, considering the recommendation of the Standing Committee of the Academic Council ordered to place the matter before the Syndicate, to take decision on mercy chance.
6. The meeting of the Syndicate held on 18/02/2026 considered the matter and vide paper



read (10), resolved to conduct Mercy Chance Examinations by levying a Re-registration fee of ₹5000/- (Rupees five thousand only) and Course fee of ₹2000/- (Rupees two thousand only).

7. The Resolution of the Syndicate vide Item No. 2026.051 dated 18/02/2026 has been implemented.
8. In view of the Resolution of the Syndicate (as per paper read 10), implemented in the University, **sanction has been accorded to conduct Mercy Chance Examinations to the Candidates of UG Programmes under Choice Based Credit Semester System (2014 Regulation) and PG Programmes under Credit Based Semester System (2014 Regulation), in Affiliated Colleges, levying the Fee, as mentioned in Paragraph (6) above.**
9. The Examination Branch shall take further action for the conduct of the Mercy Chance Examinations to the UG and PG students of 2014 (Regulations) in affiliated Colleges , by levying the Fee as mentioned in Para (6)above.
10. Orders are issued accordingly.
